### **KEMENTERIAN SAINS, TEKNOLOGI DAN INOVASI**

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#### **PENDAFTARAN NICE 2026 KINI DIBUKA, MEMACU INOVASI MALAYSIA KE PASARAN GLOBAL**

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**KUALA LUMPUR, 6 OGOS 2026** – Pendaftaran untuk *National Innovation & Commercialisation Expo* (NICE) 2026 kini dibuka. NICE 2026 menawarkan platform utama negara yang menghubungkan penyelidik dan inovator dengan industri, pelaburan serta peluang pengkomersialan dan akses pasaran. Dianjurkan oleh Kementerian Sains, Teknologi dan Inovasi (MOSTI) dengan Malaysian Research Accelerator for Technology and Innovation (MRANTI) sebagai agensi pelaksana, NICE 2026 akan berlangsung pada 26 hingga 28 Ogos 2026 di Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre (KLCC).

Pembukaan pendaftaran diumumkan hari ini menerusi prapelancongan digital NICE 2026 yang menampilkan YB Datuk Chang Lih Kang, Menteri Sains, Teknologi dan Inovasi bersama Ketua Pegawai Eksekutif MRANTI, Ashran Dato' Ghazi. Bertemakan "Dari Misi ke Pasaran. Malaysia ke Dunia." NICE 2026 mencerminkan aspirasi Malaysia untuk mempercepatkan perjalanan teknologi dan inovasi tempatan daripada peringkat penyelidikan dan pembangunan kepada penerimgunaan industri, pengkomersialan serta penembusan pasaran serantau dan global.



YB Datuk Chang Lih Kang berkata NICE 2026 menyokong usaha kerajaan untuk memastikan keupayaan negara dalam bidang sains, teknologi dan inovasi diterjemahkan kepada hasil ekonomi dan sosial yang boleh diukur. Malaysia mempunyai bakat, teknologi dan inovasi untuk bersaing di peringkat global. Keutamaan kami adalah untuk memastikan lebih banyak penyelidikan dan inovasi tempatan mampu berkembang melangkaui Malaysia,” katanya.

Meneruskan legasi *Malaysia Commercialisation Year* (MCY) yang telah menyokong pengkomersialan sebanyak 761 inovasi serta menjana lebih RM1.14 bilion pendapatan komersial, NICE memperluaskan platform ini bagi mewujudkan hubungan yang lebih kukuh antara inovator, industri, pelabur dan pasaran. NICE 2026 bakal menghimpunkan lebih 50 pemikir, pakar industri, pembuat dasar, pelabur dan pengamal teknologi di samping menampilkan lebih 180 inovasi dan teknologi daripada pelbagai sektor strategik. Selain pameran, program selama tiga hari ini merangkumi persidangan yang memberi tumpuan kepada *Advanced & Future Industries*, *HealthTech*, *Bioeconomy*, *DeepTech*, *Commercialisation* dan *Market Access*. Turut diadakan ialah sesi padanan perniagaan, *pitching*, *Tech Talk*, *podcast* dan peluang jaringan strategik.

Platform ini diwujudkan bagi merapatkan jurang antara penyelidikan dan pasaran dengan membuka akses kepada rakan industri, pelabur, pelanggan serta peluang pengkomersialan yang diperlukan untuk mempercepatkan penerimgunaan teknologi tempatan.

Ashran Dato' Ghazi, Ketua Pegawai Eksekutif MRANTI, berkata NICE diwujudkan untuk membuka peluang yang melangkaui pameran teknologi semata-mata. "Di NICE 2026, kami percaya bahawa inovasi hanya memberi nilai apabila ia sampai ke pasaran dan memberi impak kepada masyarakat. Oleh itu, NICE menghimpunkan inovator, pemain industri, pelabur dan rakan strategik dalam satu platform yang membuka peluang kepada kerjasama, pengkomersialan dan akses pasaran. NICE bukan sekadar sebuah ekspo tetapi platform yang menghubungkan inovasi dengan peluang sebenar daripada makmal ke pasaran, dan daripada Malaysia ke dunia."

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**KUALA LUMPUR, 6 AUGUST 2026** – Registration is now open for the National Innovation & Commercialisation Expo (NICE) 2026, Malaysia's premier platform connecting researchers and innovators with industry, investors, commercialisation opportunities and market access. Organised by the Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation (MOSTI), with the Malaysian Research Accelerator for Technology and Innovation (MRANTI) as the implementing agency, NICE 2026 will take place from 26 to 28 August 2026 at the Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre (KLCC).

NICE 2026 will bring together more than 50 thought leaders, industry experts, policymakers, investors and technology practitioners, while showcasing over 180 innovations and technologies across a wide range of strategic sectors. Beyond the exhibition, the three-day programme features conferences focusing on Advanced & Future Industries, HealthTech, Bioeconomy, DeepTech, Commercialisation and Market Access, alongside business matching sessions, technology pitching sessions, Tech Talks, podcasts and strategic networking opportunities.

The platform is designed to bridge the gap between research and the marketplace by providing innovators with access to industry partners, investors, customers and commercialisation opportunities needed to accelerate the adoption of local technologies.
