**MALAYSIA MARITIME WEEK 2026 TO BRING TOGETHER GLOBAL MARITIME LEADERS,
STRENGTHENING MALAYSIA'S POSITION AS A REGIONAL MARITIME AND LOGISTICS HUB**

PUTRAJAYA, 10 Ogos, 2026 – The Ministry of Transport Malaysia (MOT), in strategic collaboration with the Malaysia International Shipping Corporation (MISC) and Malaysia Shipowners' Association (MASA), will host Malaysia Maritime Week 2026 (MMW2026) from 28 September to 2 October 2026 at the Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre (KLCC). The prestigious event is expected to be Malaysia's premier maritime platform, bringing together policymakers, industry leaders, international organisations, financial institutions, academia and maritime stakeholders from across the globe.

Held under the theme "From Ambition to Action: Powering Maritime Excellence", MMW2026 reflects Malaysia's commitment to translating maritime ambitions, policies and commitments into meaningful action through stronger collaboration, innovation, investment and sustainable maritime development. The theme also aligns with World Maritime Day 2026, which highlights the importance of collective action in addressing global challenges, including energy transition, shipping decarbonisation, supply chain resilience and maritime talent development.

As Malaysia's flagship maritime platform, MMW2026 serves as a strategic economic and maritime diplomacy initiative that reinforces Malaysia's engagement with the international maritime community, supports the country's active participation in the agenda of the International Maritime Organization (IMO), and showcases Malaysia's commitment towards a sustainable, resilient and future-ready maritime sector.

More than 1,000 participants from Malaysia and abroad are expected to attend MMW2026, including ministers, policymakers, regulators, international organisations, financial institutions, shipping companies, port operators, academics, industry associations and maritime professionals to discuss strategic issues shaping the future of the global maritime industry.

Over the five-day programme, MMW2026 will feature a comprehensive line-up of strategic engagements, including the Strategic Roundtable Forum, Maritime Financing Engagement, Official Opening Ceremony, Opening Plenary, Leadership Dialogue, conference tracks on Decarbonisation, Port and Logistics, Safety and Security, and Education and Talent, the ALAM Maritime Open Day, the Malaysia Maritime Icon Award and an Industry Exhibition featuring up to 80 exhibition booths from government agencies, industry players and international maritime organisations.

MMW2026 is expected to be the most comprehensive edition since its introduction in 2014, adopting a flagship programme complemented by a series of satellite programmes throughout the week. This expanded approach is designed to broaden stakeholder participation across government, industry, financial institutions, academia and future maritime professionals while strengthening collaboration across the maritime ecosystem.

Through MMW2026, Malaysia aims to strengthen strategic international partnerships, promote investments in maritime infrastructure and green shipping, accelerate maritime decarbonisation, enhance regional cooperation, foster maritime innovation and digitalisation, and reinforce the country's position as a leading maritime and logistics hub in the Asia-Pacific region.
