**BELAGA, 17 JULY 2025** – Yang Berhormat Datuk Wilson Ugak Anak Kumbong, **Deputy Minister of Digital**, officiated the ***Jelajah Komuniti Digital*** programme held at Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan (SMK) Belaga, Sarawak.
