MALAYSIA MEMPERKUKUH KEPIMPINAN STANDARD HALAL GLOBAL DENGAN MENGANJURKAN MINGGU JAWATANKUASA TEKNIKAL SMIIC KE-14

KUALA LUMPUR, 19 SEPTEMBER 2025 – Malaysia sekali lagi mengesahkan kedudukannya sebagai peneraju global dalam ekosistem halal dengan menjadi tuan rumah **Minggu Jawatankuasa Teknikal ke-14 Institut Standard dan Metrologi untuk Negara-negara Islam (14TH TC WEEK SMIIC)**. Acara berprestij ini akan berlangsung di Hotel Impiana, KLCC pada **22 hingga 26 September 2025**.

Penganjuran **14TH TC Week SMIIC** di Malaysia merupakan acara yang julung kalinya diadakan di luar Istanbul, Türkiye dan ianya menjadi mercu tanda bersejarah bagi SMIIC dan juga Malaysia. Dianjurkan sempena **Sidang Kemuncak Halal Global (GHAS) 2025** acara ini diyakini dapat memperkukuh penyertaan Malaysia dalam aktiviti standardisasi serta menyediakan platform dalam membangun standard OIC/SMIIC berkaitan halal.

14TH TC Week SMIIC merupakan platform mesyuarat teknikal tahunan yang menghimpunkan para pakar dari negara-negara anggota SMIIC. Sesi ini amat penting bagi membincangkan, membangunkan, dan memuktamadkan draf standard SMIIC, terutamanya yang berkaitan isu halal serta bidang lain yang relevan kepada dunia Islam. Peranan Malaysia sebagai peneraju terbukti melalui penglibatan aktif pakar-pakar negara dalam pembangunan pelbagai standard OIC/SMIIC yang berkaitan,

Sehingga kini, Malaysia telah mengetuai beberapa projek pembangunan standard penting, termasuklah:

- **Pengurusan Rantaian Bekalan Halal untuk Pelabuhan/Terminal (OIC/SMIIC CD 17)**, diketuai oleh **Kapten Mohamed Halmi Shahidin** dari Johor Port Berhad.
- **Keperluan Am Penyediaan dan Pengendalian Makanan Halal Dalam Penerbangan (OIC/SMIIC CD 58)**, diterajui oleh **Encik Johari Mustapha** dari Malaysia Airports Holdings Berhad (MAHB).
- **Klasifikasi Spa Kesejahteraan untuk Pelancongan Halal (OIC/SMIIC DS 8)**, di bawah pimpinan **Dato' Dr. Mohmed Razip Hasan**, mantan Ketua Pengarah Pusat Pelancongan Islam (ITC).
- **Pelancongan Perubatan Halal (OIC/SMIIC WD 69)**, diketuai oleh **Puan Yusriana Mohd Yusoff** dari Halal Development Corporation (HDC).

- **Teknik Pengujian untuk Pengecaman Kulit Khinzir (OIC/SMIIC AWI 43)**, diterajui oleh **Dr. Padillah Yahya** dari Jabatan Kimia Malaysia (JKM).
- **Farmaseutikal Halal – Keperluan untuk Biofarmaseutikal/Vaksin (OIC/SMIIC CD 50-2)**, di bawah pimpinan pakar bebas, **Dato' Muhammad Lukmani Ibrahim**.

Kepimpinan Malaysia dalam projek-projek ini menunjukkan sumbangan yang signifikan dalam pembangunan standard yang akan diguna pakai di peringkat antarabangsa.

Menurut YBr. Encik See Che Kong, Ketua Pengarah JSM, penganjuran *14TH TC Week SMIIC* di Kuala Lumpur adalah satu penghormatan besar yang mencerminkan peranan proaktif Malaysia dalam arena standardisasi global. Malaysian Standards (MS) berkaitan halal telah lama diiktiraf dan sering dijadikan rujukan serta penanda aras dalam pembangunan standard OIC/SMIIC. Ini membuktikan kualiti dan kredibiliti ekosistem halal kita yang menyeluruh.

Acara selama lima hari ini dijangka akan mempercepatkan proses pembangunan beberapa standard penting sekaligus dapat memperkukuhkan rangkaian kerjasama antara negara anggota, seterusnya memacu pertumbuhan industri halal global.

MALAYSIA STRENGTHENS GLOBAL HALAL STANDARD LEADERSHIP BY HOSTING 14TH SMIIC TECHNICAL COMMITTEE WEEK

KUALA LUMPUR, 22 SEPTEMBER 2025 – Malaysia reaffirms its position as a global leader in the halal ecosystem by hosting the 14th Technical Committee Week of the Standards and Metrology Institute for Islamic Countries (14th TC Week SMIIC). This prestigious event is scheduled for **September 22 to 26, 2025, in Hotel Impiana, KLCC.**

The hosting of the 14th SMIIC TC Week in Malaysia marks the first time of the event is being held outside of Istanbul, Türkiye, making it a historic milestone for both SMIIC and Malaysia. Organised in conjunction with the **Global Halal Summit (GHAS) 2025** as a collaborative initiative among several national agencies, this event strengthens Malaysia's participation in SMIIC standardisation activities while providing a platform to play an active role in determining halal-related OIC/SMIIC standards.

The 14th SMIIC TC Week is an annual technical committee meeting of the Standards and Metrology Institute for Islamic Countries (SMIIC). These meetings bring together experts from member countries to discuss, develop, and deliberate SMIIC standards related to halal issues and other areas relevant to the Islamic world.

Malaysia has led the development of several key standard projects, including:

- **Halal Supply Chain Management for Port/Terminal (OIC/SMIIC CD 17)**, led by **Captain Mohamed Halmi Shahidin** of Johor Port Berhad.
- **General Requirements for Preparation and Handling of Halal In-Flight Meals (OIC/SMIIC CD 58)**, led by **Mr. Johari Mustapha** of Malaysia Airports Holdings Berhad (MAHB).
- **Wellness Spa Classification for Halal Tourism (OIC/SMIIC DS 8)**, under the leadership of **Dato' Dr. Mohmed Razip Hasan**, former Director-General of the Islamic Tourism Centre (ITC).
- **Halal Medical Tourism (OIC/SMIIC WD 69)**, led by **Puan Yusriana Mohd Yusoff** of the Halal Development Corporation (HDC).
- **Testing Techniques for the Identification of Pig Skin (OIC/SMIIC AWI 43)**, led by **Dr. Padillah Yahya** of the Department of Chemistry Malaysia (JKM).

- **Halal Pharmaceuticals – Requirements for Biopharmaceuticals/Vaccines (OIC/SMIIC CD 50-2)**, under the leadership of independent expert, **Dato' Muhammad Lukmani Ibrahim**.

Malaysia's leadership in these projects demonstrates a significant contribution to shaping standards that will be adopted internationally.

According to Mr. See Che Kong, Director-General of JSM, "Hosting the 14th SMIIC TC Week in Kuala Lumpur is an honour that reflects Malaysia's proactive role in the global standardisation arena. Malaysian Standards (MS) on halal have long been recognised and are often used as a reference and benchmark in the development of OIC/SMIIC standards. This proves the quality and credibility of our comprehensive halal ecosystem."

This five-day event is expected to accelerate the development process for several key standards, strengthen collaborative networks among member countries, and in turn, drive the growth of the global halal industry.
