NICE 2026 PACU KERJASAMA STRATEGIK BERNILAI RM157.2 JUTA, PERKUKUH AGENDA PENGKOMERSIALAN DAN INOVASI NEGARA

KUALA LUMPUR, 28 OGOS 2026 – National Innovation & Commercialisation Expo (NICE) 2026 anjuran melabuhkan tirai hari ini dengan merekodkan Memorandum Persefahaman (MoU) dan Memorandum Perjanjian (MoA) strategik bernilai kira-kira **RM157.2 juta**, sekaligus memperkukuh komitmen Malaysia untuk mempercepat pengkomersialan teknologi, memperluas kerjasama industri serta membawa inovasi tempatan ke pasaran serantau dan global.

Dianjurkan oleh Kementerian Sains, Teknologi dan Inovasi (MOSTI) dengan Malaysian Research Accelerator for Technology and Innovation (MRANTI) sebagai agensi pelaksana, NICE 2026 menyokong usaha MOSTI dalam memperkukuh ekosistem sains, teknologi dan inovasi (STI) negara menerusi pengkomersialan dan penerimgunaan teknologi tempatan yang mampu menjana nilai ekonomi, meningkatkan daya saing industri serta kesejahteraan rakyat.

Sepanjang tiga hari penganjuran, NICE 2026 menghimpunkan **9,358 peserta** dan pengunjung setakat tengah hari, selain menampilkan lebih **180 pempamer** yang mengetengahkan pelbagai teknologi dan inovasi serta lebih **70 pemikir, pakar industri dan pembuat dasar dari dalam dan luar negara**.

NICE 2026 mencatat hasil pengkomersialan yang ketara menerusi MoU dan MoA bernilai **RM157.2 juta, 23 pelancaran produk, 235 sesi padanan perniagaan serta 65 sesi pitching** yang melibatkan agensi kerajaan, institusi penyelidikan, universiti, syarikat teknologi, pemain industri dan rakan strategik. Libat urus ini membuka peluang baharu untuk mempercepat pengkomersialan teknologi, memperkukuh kerjasama industri serta memperluas akses pasaran bagi inovasi Malaysia.

NICE 2026 turut meraikan kecemerlangan inovasi menerusi Anugerah Malaysia Commercialisation Year (MCY) sebagai pengiktirafan kepada penyelidik, *inovator*, usahawan dan organisasi atas pencapaian cemerlang dalam pengkomersialan, penerimgunaan teknologi dan inovasi. Materials In Works (M) Sdn. Bhd. dinobatkan sebagai penerima Anugerah Keseluruhan dan pemenang Anugerah Inovator Baharu menerusi inovasi Recovered Cellulose Pulp (RCP). Manakala pemenang kategori lain ialah Ingeniouscity Engineering Solutions Sdn. Bhd., Twin Catalyst Sdn. Bhd., Bambusoideae Technology Sdn. Bhd. dan Geomax Rubber Innovative Products Sdn. Bhd.

Berucap pada majlis penutupan, YB Dato' Haji Mohammad Yusof Apdal, Timbalan Menteri Sains, Teknologi dan Inovasi, berkata kejayaan NICE 2026 tidak harus diukur semata-mata melalui jumlah penyertaan atau nilai perjanjian yang dimeterai, tetapi berdasarkan impak jangka panjang daripada kerjasama yang terjalin.

"NICE bukan sekadar sebuah ekspo tahunan. Ia merupakan platform yang mempertemukan penyelidik dengan industri, inovator dengan pelabur serta teknologi dengan pasaran. Hubungan yang terjalin sepanjang tiga hari ini perlu diteruskan dan diterjemahkan kepada lebih banyak penerimgunaan teknologi, pengkomersialan yang berjaya serta pertumbuhan ekonomi yang mampan untuk negara."

Beliau berkata MOSTI akan terus memperkukuh ekosistem inovasi negara menerusi pelaksanaan **Dasar Sains, Teknologi dan Inovasi Negara (DSTIN) 2021–2030, Kerangka Penyelidikan, Pembangunan, Inovasi, Pengkomersialan dan Ekonomi**

(RDICE) serta **Rancangan Malaysia Ketiga Belas (RMK13)**, bagi memastikan lebih banyak teknologi tempatan memberi manfaat dan impak kepada rakyat, industri serta ekonomi negara.

Rakan strategik yang turut menjayakan NICE 2026 antaranya Malaysian Industry-Government Group for High Technology (MIGHT), MIMOS Berhad, National Institutes of Biotechnology Malaysia (NIBM) dan Malaysian Bioeconomy Development Corporation (Bioeconomy Corporation).

Selaras dengan aspirasi Malaysia untuk menjadi negara berteknologi tinggi, NICE akan terus menjadi platform pemangkin kepada kerjasama strategik, pengkomersialan dan penerimgunaan teknologi. Usaha ini penting bagi memastikan inovasi tempatan terus mencipta nilai dan berdaya saing di peringkat serantau serta global.

NICE 2026 GENERATES RM157.2 MILLION IN STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIPS, REINFORCING MALAYSIA'S COMMERCIALISATION AGENDA

KUALA LUMPUR, 28 AUGUST 2026 – The National Innovation & Commercialisation Expo (NICE) 2026 concluded today with the facilitation of approximately **RM157.2 million** worth of strategic Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) and Memoranda of Agreement (MoAs), reinforcing Malaysia's commitment to accelerating technology commercialisation, strengthening industry collaboration and bringing homegrown innovations to regional and global markets.

Organised by the Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation (MOSTI), with the Malaysian Research Accelerator for Technology and Innovation (MRANTI) as the implementing agency, NICE 2026 supports MOSTI's efforts to strengthen Malaysia's science, technology and innovation (STI) ecosystem by accelerating the commercialisation and adoption of homegrown technologies that generate economic value, strengthen industry and improve the well-being of the rakyat.

Throughout the three-day event, NICE 2026 welcomed **9,358 participants and visitors as of midday**, featured **more than 180 exhibitors** showcasing technology and innovation, and brought together **more than 70 thought leaders, industry experts and policymakers** from Malaysia and abroad.

Beyond participation, NICE 2026 generated tangible commercialisation outcomes through **RM157.2 million in MoUs and MoAs, 23 product launches, 235 business matching sessions and 65 pitching sessions** involving government agencies, research institutions, universities, technology companies, industry players and strategic partners. These engagements created new opportunities to accelerate technology commercialisation, strengthen industry partnerships and expand market access for Malaysian innovations.

The event also celebrated innovation excellence through the Malaysia Commercialisation Year (MCY) Awards, recognising researchers, innovators, entrepreneurs and organisations for outstanding achievements in commercialisation, technology adoption and innovation. Materials In Works (M) Sdn. Bhd. emerged as the Overall Award recipient and winner of the Emerging Innovator Award for its Recovered Cellulose Pulp (RCP) innovation, while other category winners included Ingeniouscity Engineering Solutions Sdn. Bhd., Twin Catalyst Sdn. Bhd., Bambusoideae Technology Sdn. Bhd. and Geomax Rubber Innovative Products Sdn. Bhd.

Speaking at the closing ceremony, YB Dato' Haji Mohammad Yusof Apdal, Deputy Minister of Science, Technology and Innovation, said the success of NICE 2026 should not be measured solely by participation figures or the value of agreements exchanged, but by the long-term collaborations and commercial opportunities generated through the event.

"NICE is more than an annual exhibition. It is a platform connecting researchers with industry, innovators with investors, and technology with markets. The relationships built over the past three days must continue beyond this event and translate into greater technology adoption, stronger commercialisation outcomes and sustainable economic growth for Malaysia."

He added that MOSTI remains committed to strengthening the nation's innovation ecosystem through strategic policies and initiatives, including the National Science, Technology and Innovation Policy (DSTIN) 2021–2030, the Research, Development, Innovation, Commercialisation and Economy (RDICE) Framework, and the Thirteenth Malaysia Plan (RMK13).

MOSTI also records its appreciation to its agencies and strategic partners, particularly Malaysian Industry-Government Group for High Technology, MIMOS Berhad, National Institutes of Biotechnology Malaysia and Malaysian Bioeconomy Development Corporation, for their valuable contributions in strengthening the content, expertise and technology showcases throughout NICE 2026.

As Malaysia advances its aspiration to become a High-Tech Nation, NICE will continue to serve as a catalyst for collaboration, commercialisation and technology adoption, ensuring that Malaysian innovations create lasting value for industry, society and the global marketplace.
